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After Biopsy Wound Care Instructions

24/48 hours after the biopsy moisten area with a liberal amount of water and remove the pressure bandage.

If you are taking any blood thinners such as Aspirin, Coumadin, or Plavix, please remove your bandage 48 hours after the biopsy.

Apply Vaseline (petroleum jelly) to prevent scab from forming.

Cover the wound loosely with a clean band-aid. Follow this procedure 2 times a day until healed. (Usually 2 to 4 weeks)

On the face the band-aid may be left off after the first day, unless the area is apt to irritation by glasses, etc. In this case please apply Vaseline 3 times per day.
